



## **PaddleNSW Marathon Medal Policy**

### **AWARDS**

- 1.1. For a class to be contested in any PNSW State Level Competition there must be a minimum of three entries and two starters.
- 1.2. Official Paddle NSW Medals are presented based on result regardless of nationality or state association in recognised classes at all Paddle NSW Championships as follows.
  - (a) To receive a gold medal there are to be a minimum of two (2) athletes, crews or teams starting in the class;
  - (b) To receive a silver medal there are to be a minimum of three (3) athletes, crews or teams starting in the class;
  - (c) To receive a bronze medal there are to be a minimum of four (4) athletes, crews or teams starting in the class.
- 1.3. A Paddle NSW Standard medal will be presented to the highest placed Individual member of Paddle NSW where the gold medal is awarded to a non-Australian resident or a non full-member Paddle NSW representative.
- 1.4. There will be four classes for state events; K, TK, C, and Recreational
  - (a) Rec class will consist of unrestricted craft, long rec, medium rec, short rec, surf skis, and sea kayaks
  - (b) PNSW minted medals will be awarded for K, TK and C classes only. Rec classes will be awarded Standard (generic) medals.
